Howard M Everett joined the RMon RE(M) as a 2nd Lieutenant in 1930, rising to Major by 1939. On the outbreak of war in 1939, he was Officer Commanding 101 Company, and in 1940 was transferred to 100 Company. He was Lieutenant Colonel of the Regiment from 1954 to 1964.
