Horace Lloyd was born in 1916. He enlisted in the Royal Monmouthshire Royal Engineers (Militia) in 1935. At the outbreak of the Second World War, he was a member of 101 Field Company, which was sent to France in September 1939, and evacuated from Dunkirk in May 1940. Mr Lloyd later became a member of the Dunkirk Veterans Association, and of the Royal Engineers Association, Monmouth Branch.
