Bernard Francis Gibbon joined the RMonRE(M) in 1938. He was sent to France with the British Expeditionary Force in 1939, was evacuated from Dunkirk in 1940, and returned to France in 1944, when he was seriously wounded.

A small collection including army attestation papers, army Christmas cards, and a list of bridges demolished by 100 Field Company
