David A Smith joined the Royal Engineers Reserve of Officers as a Second Lieutenant in 1938, and was posted to the Royal Monmouthshire Royal Engineers. In the postwar Regiment, he became major and subsequently Lieutenant Colonel, serving as Commanding Officer 1952-1955.
